Today's immigrant and refugee youth are more at risk for deportation than ever before. With increased immigration enforcement and stricter guidelines even minor crimes like shoplifting can result in deportation. Youth who may have never lived in their home country or perhaps don't even speak the language are returning to countries where most often they do not even have remaining relatives. Immigrant students and their families need to know their rights, risks and responsibilities under current immigration law.

Administrators and educators need up-to-date information on the legal status' of their students, the school's role in the immigration system, and how to help immigrant youth and their families find reputable legal advice and education in order to protect their rights under the law.

On **Thursday, June 25, 2009**, the Immigrant Law Center of Minnesota (ILCM) in conjunction with Saint Paul Public Schools will host the ***No Second Chance Showcase for Administrators***—a training session for school administrators in Minnesota who wish to learn more about immigration law and policy, and how to educate their student population.
